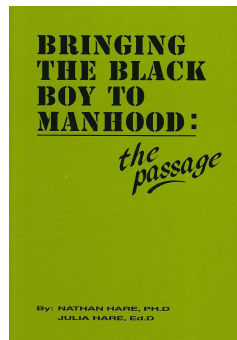

BRINGING THE BLACK BOY TO MANHOOD: THE PASSAGE
